Standard Operating Guidelines**

USE OF RESCUE RIG

1. Rescue Rig will not be used or removed from the building without a mission or training mission number.

AUTHORIZED DRIVERS

1. Completed Sheriff's Department approved driver training course.
2. Complete an equipment orientation.
3. Hold a valid driver's license.
4. Maintain POV insurance.
5. Complete an annual driver's license check to be kept on file.

PROCEDURES

1. Never back up without a spotter
2. Emergency lights will only be used when authorized by the SAR Coordinator.
3. Precheck before leaving building
  - a. Unplug shore power
  - b. Walk around vehicle to check for obstructions & close all doors
  - c. Check all fluids
  - d. Secure all contents
4. The rescue rig will be refueled before returning to the building.
5. Upon returning to the building, a post check will be done
  - a. Miles and mission log
  - b. Properly care for any equipment used
  - c. Return and put away any equipment not belonging in the rig.
  - d. Clean the interior

- e. Wash the exterior
  - f. Plug in shore power
  - g. Turn off batteries
6. All paperwork associated with use of the rescue rig will be completed within two weeks or the operator will be held financially responsible for any and all costs associated with related mission and/or incident.
